


#### Who We Are




### What We Do

The Southeastern Photographic Society promotes development of camera skills and artistic expression among its members through the following activities:

<u>Lectures</u> are presented by local and nationally known experts on various topics in photography such as travel, nature, action/ sports, and digital image production.

<u>Competitions</u> judged by local professionals who provide feedback on impact, composition, and technique to help develop strong artistic style. Some are open to any subject matter while others are limited to a specific theme, such as travel, nature, or people.

<u>Demonstrations</u> are useful for learning new techniques, such as hand coloring prints or Polaroid image transfers, as well as seeing new products such as infrared films.

<u>Special Interest Groups</u> (SIGs) offer the opportunity to participate in separate activities with smaller numbers of members with similar interests, such as nature, black & white, or "on the edge."

<u>Field trips</u> allow members to share ideas, techniques and equipment in various settings, such as Sapelo Island, the Okefenokee Swamp, and metro parks.

Annual dues for calendar year memberships are \$25 for individual and \$35 for family. Members receive a monthly newsletter, and are eligible to enter competitions and participate in field trips.


Each new member will receive a membership package with general information about the Society. If you join by mail, your packet will be available at the next meeting.
